Greg started the meeting @ 7:00 p.m.

Carlin Jones was given the floor to discuss signage for the petition.

Carlin stated that he wants to get involved by offering any person a billboard who wants to advertise to help draw attention to the petition. He said he is going to be working under his own business name but is going to take care of all details of this signage, labor, reclamation of the land, etc. He said he wants to send ideas for these signs and get feed back from the board to help have a strong message. The signs can be as large as 36' wide and he will be able to do around 12 or so of these. He is looking for Wyoming NORML to help him find locations on busy highways and major roads in every county. He gave his business website address as [www.wyomedical.com](http://www.wyomedical.com) and told the board how it gives educational information and is tied to Wyomingnorml.org and the petition.

\*Greg made a motion to accept the billboards/signage from Carlin Jones and to work with him in that endeavor, Seconded by Bennett. All approved, motion carried.

Pam asked if Greg Schuetz would be willing to be listed at the 3 committee member in the committee who is in charge of the petitions. Greg accepted this position if Lee Roith approved of it.

Carrie asked Pam if she and Lee were ok with the 420 Wyoming WWLCH group being the PAC that supports the initiative now that Wyoming NORML PAC has been inactivated.

Pam agreed that they would be fine with that PAC taking the place of the Wyoming NORML PAC.

It will be left up the PAC to file the paperwork with the Secretary of States office.

Treasurers Report Bennett reported that the EIN number for Wyoming NORML is still good and we are listed as a non-profit organization with the IRS. Verification is going to come that we are designated as a 501-3c status. We are good now to open the bank account and get going with that.

Bennett talked about a video he has been putting together in rebuttal of the testimony of the RMHIDTA group during a Judiciary meeting held in Cody. He said he went line by line to give information and education to the legislators that were involved.

Scott talked about sending in the circulators list that has to be sent to the Secretary of States office prior to the petitions being taken in.

Scott said that he does have 3 counties done and they are Park County 754 signatures to date, Laramie County has 1785 signatures collected, Natrona 1132 signatures so far. We have some ways to go but there is plenty of time to get this done.

Changes to the [www.wyomingnorml.org](http://www.wyomingnorml.org) site were discussed. Some things will be taken down but some of that will be added back to the site.

Gillette and Sheridan College events were discussed. These events are to help that county circulators know how to do an event and how to work out in the public. Greg and Scott will be going to those events.

Reed Eckhart has been doing some great press at the Wyoming Eagle out of Cheyenne for us. The POTluck dinner was talked about. The Basin Reboot was discussed as a good source in Park County for media. WIFE was talked about as an ally to talk to the local farmers and get support from them.

Derick Farmer is holding a gathering where he will give a speech and then ask everyone join him in signing our petition. Mr. Farmer has requested that we have someone available with a petition so he and others can sign.

Greg said he wanted to remind everyone that the Governors Marijuana impact council is meeting tomorrow at 122 w. 25<sup>th</sup> St. in the Herschler Building from 8-10 a.m. in room 1699, Cheyenne. [www.Gmiac.wyo.gov](http://www.Gmiac.wyo.gov) is the website but it is not easy to find out about the meetings.

Scott reminded Carrie to get the by-laws listed on the website.

\*Greg made a motion to approve the board minutes from December, seconded by Scott. Carrie, Greg, Scott approved with Bennett abstaining, motion carried.

Max Meadows has agreed to print business cards for the board at cost.

Greg made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Bennett seconded the motion, all approved. Meeting was adjourned.
